He played a key role in growing a \$100M+ revenue financial firm, Morgan Keegan, into a \$500M firm with over 2000 employees. As President and COO, he initiated and teamed with top management to negotiate, structure and execute the sale of the firm at/near the peak of the market in 2000/2001. More importantly, Laffey headed a 20 member transition team that RETAINED ALL EMPLOYEES and benefited shareholders, customers and employees, including access to more capital and a 36% increase in stock price.

An engaging public speaker, radio show host, guest lecturer, and keynote speaker Laffey has been featured on national broadcast media such as Fox News Special Report, This Week with George Stephanopoulos, The O'Reilly Factor (FOX News), MSNBC's Hardball with Chris Matthews, CNN's Situation Room with Bill Schneider, Lou Dobbs Tonight (FOX Business), CNN Morning News, and C-SPAN.

His Book, *Primary Mistake* (Penguin Books, 2007), is a grassroots work, showing what happens when a political party gets so obsessed with holding on to power that it abandons its core principles.
